The Alliance for Education is the only organization of its kind serving all of **Seattle Public Schools**. The Alliance serves as a convener, connector and collaborator, stewarding philanthropic funding, innovation and expertise to ensure that every public school in Seattle has the resources they need. The Alliance's work is designed to challenge systemic inequities in public schools and create a more equitable education system that allows all Seattle students to thrive. Since its founding in 1995, the Alliance has raised and **invested more than \$180 million to support** and improve public education in Seattle.

Our Work



Prepares educators to teach in culturally and linguistically diverse communities and places highly-qualified teachers in Title I elementary schools with students furthest from educational justice.



Right Now Needs Fund Addresses the immediate needs of students and families, to enable them to fully participate in classroom activities by covering the cost of expenses such as warm clothing, meals, and housing that are not included in individual school budgets.



Works with nearly 175 school-serving community groups to help streamline accounting services for their fundraising efforts on behalf of students. By offering fiscal services to support school-related fundraising, the Alliance reduces barriers, allowing school volunteers and staff more time to focus on school programs and fundraising.
